SCHOOL BAND/DRILL TEAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. In accordance with the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association (SCSBOA) Rules and Regulation band entries will be accepted for competition in two divisions, Intermediate/Junior High School and High School. High school entries will be divided into Class A and Class AA according to school enrollment.
2. School band and drill team fees are non-refundable. (See fees on application).
3. The judge's stand will be located at the southwest corner of Las Tunas Drive at Alessandro Avenue.
4. According to the stipulated rule prescribed by the SCSBOA a silent area will precede the designated HALT line. Judge representatives will meet all bands with a HALT sign to assist all drum majors. No other Halt will be permitted.
5. Bands/drill teams will not be permitted to HALT at the main grandstands. Grandstands are located on Temple City Boulevard at Las Tunas Drive.
6. Bands shall maintain a position no more than 100 feet behind the proceeding unit. Due to the variety of parade entries, parade route flow is a necessity.
7. Bands are required to choose their music from the current SCSBOA Competition Parade Music List. Once your band has passed the competition area, you're free to play the groups favorite selections. PLEASE PLAY DURING THE ENTIRE PARADE.
8. Band musical scores can either be mailed to the Camellia Festival office prior to Wednesday February 22, 2012 or hand delivered to the judges stand one hour before the start of the parade.
9. Roving Judges will be on the parade route and will judge bands on their overall musical selections and performances. Please play during the entire parade except the silent area. A trophy will be awarded to the most enthusiastic band.
10. Drill teams units, flag corps and/or marching squads will not be eligible unless accompanied by a band, by invitation only on approval of the Executive Committee of the Camellia Festival.
11. **No motor driven vehicles, roller skates, skateboards, bicycles, unicycles or animals of any kind will be permitted to accompany your unit in the parade.**
12. Band Parents (Groomers) that follow bands must stay clear of the judges. Point deduction may be made.
