CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of July 6, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The official record of the Meeting is the Minutes once approved by the City Council.

At the meeting of July 6, 2010, the City Council:

- Approved a request for placement and removal of a street banner by St. Luke School;
- Accepted work and approved full payment to Stars Electric for work performed on Temple City Park Walkway Lighting Retrofit Project;
- Authorized City Manager to apply for the State-Legislated Safe Routes to School Program Grant;
- Received updates and presentation from Buxton Company, and provided staff with direction on how to follow through on preparation and delivery of Temple City's Pursuit Packages to present to national retailers. A City Council Ad Hoc Committee was also created (i.e., Councilmember Sternquist and Councilmember Yu) to assist staff in the preparation of the Pursuit Packages;
- Adopted Resolution ordering levy and collection of assessments of Citywide Lighting and Maintenance District for FY 2010-2011;
- Received a monthly update from the Chamber of Commerce President on the Chamber's recent and upcoming events and new memberships;
- Approved the project agreement between the Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency and the San Gabriel Valley Habitat for Humanity, Inc; and
- Received Council Reports on recent meetings of the Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project Ad Hoc Committee Meeting and Protocol Ad Hoc Committee Meeting.
