CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of June 15, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of June 15, 2010, the City Council:

- Received the preliminary results of the Athens Waste Collection Option Survey and conducted a drawing for three winners of one year of free trash service. The winners were: George Moreno – Myda Avenue, Richard Luevano – Rosemead Blvd, and V. Cox – La Rosa Drive.
- Approved the design and specifications for new playground equipment at Live Oak Park and authorized staff to solicit construction bids.
- Approved General Facilities Use Agreements with the Temple City Unified School District and the El Monte City School District.
- Adopted a Resolution approving a Statement of Investment Policy for the City, Community Redevelopment Agency and the Financing Authority.
- Approved a Final Map for a subdivision of four detached condominium dwelling units at 5013 – 5015 Farago Avenue.
- Adopted a Resolution authorizing the City's participation in the Los Angeles County Energy Program (LACEP).
- Adopted a Resolution declaring support for an energy partnership between the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments, Southern California Edison, and the City of Temple City.
- Adopted a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to submit grant applications to the State of California Department of Resources and Recycling (CalRecycle).
- Adopted an Ordinance amending sections of the Temple City Municipal Code relating to the overnight parking permit process and set a public hearing on June 29, 2010 for adoption of a temporary fee structure.
- Adopted an Ordinance amending sections of the Temple City Municipal Code to revise the duties of the Public Safety Commission.
- Re-appointed Chris Goad and Peggy Miller to the Parks and Recreation Commission and re-appointed Jerry Seibert and Tom O'Leary to the Planning Commission for terms ending June 30, 2012.
- Approved a request from the Chamber of Commerce for use of the City's parking lot at 9050 Las Tunas Drive for a Summer Mixer/Barbecue on July 19, 2010.
- Received Council Reports on recent meetings of the Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project Ad Hoc Committee Meeting, Protocol Ad Hoc Committee Meeting, and the Foothill Transit Zone Governing Board Meeting.
