**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of March 16, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The official record of the Meeting is the Minutes once approved by the City Council.

At the meeting of March 16, 2010, the City Council:

- Added a Subsequent Need Item to the Agenda and Adopted a Resolution Appointing Carl L. Blum to the City Council for the remainder of the unexpired term of the seat vacated due to the resignation of Judy Wong
- Presented a Donation of “50 Books for 50 Years” to the Temple City Library as Part of the City’s 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration
- Awarded a Contract for the Temple City Park Walkway Lighting Retrofit Project
- Awarded a Professional Services Agreement with Mathis Consulting Group to coordinate and facilitate the City Council Goal Setting Workshop in April 2010
- Adopted a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for a Caltrans Community Based Transportation Planning Grant on behalf of the City
- Adopted an Ordinance to conditionally permit the storage of recreation vehicles and boats in the heavy commercial (C-3) zone
- Denied a Conditional Use Permit to allow the installation of a wireless telecommunications facility (monopine) at 5221 El Monte Avenue
- Adopted a Resolution approving the Mayor’s appointments to City Council Committees and Delegates/Alternates to other agencies and organizations
- Approved a total appropriation of \$18,800 to be used by the Temple City Chamber of Commerce to publish and mail the *Temple City Lifestyle* magazine to all businesses and residences in the City, with reimbursement to the City of some portion of the advertising revenues
- Considered establishing a Historic Preservation Program as part of the City’s 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration and future goals setting session
- As Housing Authority Members – received an update regarding the partnership with Habitat for Humanity to create a Housing Rehabilitation Program and scheduled the agreement to be scheduled for approval at a subsequent meeting
