CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of June 1, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of June 1, 2010, the City Council:

- Approved a progress payment, in the amount of \$40,324.32, for construction services performed thus far on the New Traffic Signals Projects on Temple City Boulevard at Ellis Lane.
- Approved a progress payment, in the amount of \$450,466.25, for construction services performed thus far on the Freer Street Asphalt Overlay Project.
- Approved a street closure for Oak Avenue Elementary School for their Promotion Ceremony on June 17, 2010 from 4:30 – 8:30 p.m.
- Authorized release of security, in the amount of \$62,700.00, upon completion of sewer improvements at 5527-5545 Sultana Avenue.
- Adopted a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for a National Trust for Historic Preservation (NTHP) Grant in the maximum amount of \$10,000.00.
- Expanded the Dial-A-Ride eligibility to include residents of certain unincorporated county areas adjacent to Temple City (with some restrictions) for a trial period of three months.
- Introduced an Ordinance amending sections of the Temple City Municipal Code relating to the overnight parking permit process and set a public hearing for adoption of a temporary fee structure.
- Introduced an Ordinance amending sections of the Temple City Municipal Code relating to reinstating the Public Safety Commission and revising its duties.
- Approved the creation of a City Council Ad Hoc Committee to discuss and develop City Council and City Commission protocols and appointed Mayor Pro Tem Chavez and Councilmember Blum as initial members of that Committee.
- Received a monthly update from the Chamber of Commerce President on the Chamber's recent and upcoming events and new memberships.
- Received a Council Ad Hoc Committee Report on a recent meeting of the School District/City Ad Hoc Committee Meeting.
