At the meeting of February 16, 2010, the City Council:

- Approved Award of Contract to Hirsch & Associates, Inc. for Landscape Architectural Services for the Renovation of the Circular Planter at Live Oak Park
- Received Audit Reports for Proposition A, Proposition C and Transportation Development Act Article 3 for Fiscal Year 2008-2009
- Approved an Agreement with Revenue & Cost Specialists (RCS) to Prepare a Cost Allocation Plan and Comprehensive User Fee Study
- Authorized Completion of Construction of Additional ADA Wheelchair Access Ramps for a Safe Route to School for Temple City Students
- Approved Award of Contract with Traffic Operations Inc. for the Las Tunas Traffic Paint Refreshing Project
- Approved a Consultant Services Agreement with the Buxton Company for a Retail Development Strategy that Enhances the City's Ability to Recruit National Retailers to the City
- Provided Direction to Staff to Revamp the Annual Parking Permit Application Process to Effectively Address the Public's Concerns
- Provided Input to the Ad Hoc Chambers Renovation Committee to Include ADA Podium Accommodations for Those Wishing to Address the City Council
- Directed the City Manager and Staff to Initiate and Schedule Regular Informal Meetings of City Councilmembers and Residents
- As City Council and Community Redevelopment Agency Members, Approved a Consultant Services Agreement with Seifel Consulting Inc. for Redevelopment Advisory Services and a Redevelopment 101 Presentation
