CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of April 6, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The official record of the Meeting is the Minutes once approved by the City Council.

At the meeting of April 6, 2010, the City Council:

- Recognized those citizens who aided in a January 2010 house fire rescue on Bogue Street
- Proclaimed April 11 through 17, 2010 as National Library Week
- Received an update on the membership benefits of the San Gabriel Valley Economic Partnership
- Approved a Final Map for the subdivision of an existing 20,164 square foot parcel into two separate lots to accommodate one single family dwelling on each of the two lots at 4851 Heleo Avenue
- Approved an Agency-State Agreement for Federal aid for the upgrade of traffic signals on Temple City Boulevard & Las Tunas Drive and Baldwin Avenue & Olive Street Project
- Approved the use of Temple City's share of Fiscal Year 2009-2010 appropriation of Proposition 1B Transportation Bond Funds in the amount of \$530,758.14 toward the Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project
- Adopted a resolution designating April 4 through April 10, 2010 as Community Development Block Grant Week to celebrate and support the Community Development Block Grant Program
- Adopted a resolution denying a Conditional Use Permit which would have allowed the installation of a wireless telecommunications facility at 5221 El Monte Avenue
- Selected a location in Temple City Park for placement of a bronze bust of Walter P. Temple
- Adopted an Urgency Ordinance extending the moratorium on medical marijuana dispensaries and the distribution of medical marijuana at businesses in the City for an additional year, expiring on April 21, 2011
- Denied a Zone Change and General Plan Amendment to reclassify a property at 4910 Encinita Avenue from the "residential" R-2 category to the "manufacturing" M-1 category
- Approved the formation of a Council Ad Hoc Committee, comprised of Councilmembers Blum and Yu to oversee the streetscape design of the Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project
