**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of May 4, 2010. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The official record of the Meeting is the Minutes once approved by the City Council.

At the meeting of May 4, 2010, the City Council:

- Presented a Proclamation to Dan Snell, Temple City's Outstanding Older American for 2009, proclaiming the month of May as Older Americans Month.
- Presented a Proclamation to Peggy McIntosh, of the American Legion Auxiliary, proclaiming the week of May 9 – May 15 as Poppy Week.
- Presented a donation of books to the Temple City Library as Part of the City's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration of "50 Books for 50 Years".
- Heard a presentation from the Los Angeles County Bicycle Coalition suggesting that a bicycle plan be incorporated into the City's downtown redevelopment plans.
- Authorized solicitation of bids for traffic signal upgrades on Temple City Boulevard at Las Tunas Drive and Baldwin Avenue at Olive Street.
- Approved a request from the American Cancer Society for the City to co-sponsor the Southern California Chinese Relay for Life Event at Temple City High School on June 26-27, 2010.
- Adopted a resolution approving a City Meeting Invocation Policy.
- Received an update on events and activities of the Chamber of Commerce from the Chamber President/CEO.
- Appointed Councilmember Sternquist as Council Liaison to the Temple City Sister City Organization, and Mayor Pro Tem Chavez as Alternate Liaison.
- Received an update from staff regarding the City's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary planned events and activities.
- Received Council Ad Hoc and Committee Reports on recent meetings of the: Ad Hoc Budget Committee; Council Chambers Renovation Ad Hoc Committee; Youth Committee; and Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project Ad Hoc Committee.
