

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY**  
**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of December 20, 2011. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of December 20, 2011, the City Council:

- Received an update of recent State legislation from Senator Carol Liu.
- Approved the final progress payment, in the amount of \$300, to Hirsch & Associates, Inc. for work performed on the Live Oak Park Circular Planter Renovation Project.
- Authorized the City Manager to execute a Letter of Agreement with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) to ensure that the City is able to obligate funds for the Rosemead Boulevard Beautification Project.
- Adopted a Resolution approving and adopting the City's Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).
- Approved Amendment No. 6 to the Consultant Services Agreement with Gruen Associates, totaling \$23,935, to provide the City with additional design and survey services for the Rosemead Boulevard Safety Enhancements and Beautification Project.
- Adopted a Resolution memorializing the implementation of a 1% reduction of employer paid member contribution to the California Public Employees' Retirement System for full-time employees hired before January 1, 2012
- Adopted a Resolution eliminating payment of employer paid member contributions to the California Public Employees' Retirement System for employees hired on or after January 1, 2012.
- Conducted a Public Hearing to review the Planning Commission's decision approving a Conditional Use Permit allowing the establishment of a pre-school/kindergarten at 5537 Temple City Boulevard, determined that additional information was required based on testimony received, and directed that this matter be re-noticed for a public hearing on February 7, 2012.
- Conducted a Public Hearing and introduced, on first reading, Ordinance No. 11-951 amending the Downtown Specific Plan to conditionally permit dance and exercise schools/studios in the East Commercial (EC) District of the Downtown Specific Plan.
- Received the Chamber of Commerce Monthly Report from newly appointed President Peter Choi who provided information on the Chamber's new focus and direction for the future.
- Received a Council report on a recent planning meeting of the Temple City Citizens Academy proposed to begin in Spring of 2012.
- As the Community Redevelopment Agency, adopted a Resolution approving the Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency Annual Report for July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.
