CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of November 15, 2011. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of November 15, 2011, the City Council:

- Presented Certificates of Recognition to the student winners of the Library Bookmark Contest.
- Accepted the work performed by Aramexx Construction on the Live Oak Park and Temple City Park Planter Renovation and Monument Sign Project and approved final payment in the amount of \$22,452.75.
- Approved the request from the American Cancer Society for the City to co-sponsor the Relay for Life of the Chinese Community South at Live Oak Park on April 14-15, 2012.
- Approved the Final Parcel Map for construction to begin for four-unit condominium subdivision at 6308-6314 Oak Avenue, consistent with the land use designation and R-2 zoning standards of the City.
- Adopted on second reading an Ordinance complying with the Alternative Voluntary Redevelopment Program to continue existence and operation of the Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency.
- Introduced on first reading an Ordinance establishing consistent standards for prohibiting the removal of shopping and laundry carts from business locations that offer carts to customers and providing for the timely removal of carts from public property.
- Introduced on first reading an Ordinance establishing a program requiring banks that commence a foreclosure process to accept responsibility for the maintenance and security of those properties that become vacant or abandoned and would be subject to the City's public nuisance ordinance and imposition of fines and/or initiation of criminal proceedings.
- Introduced on first reading an Ordinance establishing regulations that will promote the sound maintenance of property and enhance the appearance, use and safety of all structures and premises in the City and providing the City the ability to recover all of its costs when abating public nuisances.
- Received and filed the Temple City Chamber of Commerce monthly report for October 2011.
- Received Council reports on recent meetings of the Historical Society Building Joint Use Ad Hoc Committee and the Public Art Advisory Group Ad Hoc Committee.
- Received a report from Councilmember Sternquist on a new pocket park in the City of Maywood that was funded through the Trust for Public Land and referred the issue of initiating a similar project in Temple City to the Parks and Recreation Commission for further study.
