CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of October 18, 2011. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of October 18, 2011, the City Council:

- Received a presentation from representatives of the American Heart Association and the County Department of Public Health proposing a smoking prohibition in outdoor dining areas.
- Heard a presentation from a representative of the Emerald Necklace Group advocating the linking of a green infrastructure connecting cities from the mountains to the sea named The Emerald Necklace.
- Approved a progress payment to Aramexx Construction in the amount of \$29,476.61 for work performed on the Live Oak Park Circular Planter Renovation Project.
- Appropriated grant funding in the amount of \$73,622 Highway Safety Improvement Program funds and \$13,180 Measure R funds for the Traffic Signal Upgrades on Temple City Boulevard at Las Tunas Drive and Baldwin Avenue at Olive Street Project and approved a change order in the amount of \$81,803 to cover costs associated with the project.
- Authorized release of securities in the amount of \$41,000 upon completion of sanitary sewer improvements at 6047 Temple City Boulevard, Tract No. 061386.
- Received the Chamber of Commerce Monthly Report of events and activities for the month of September.
- Welcomed Captain Chris Nee, the newly appointed head of Temple Sheriff Station.
- Received Council reports on the California Downtown Association Conference, California Contract Cities Seminar, Public Art Advisory Committee meeting, and the second Rosemead Boulevard Improvement Project Community meeting.
- Received the Mayor's report on recent City Hall meetings with residents.
