

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY**  
**CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of October 4, 2011. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the Meeting.

At the meeting of October 4, 2011, the City Council:

- Welcomed six Sister City exchange students visiting from Hawkesbury, Australia.
- Approved a progress payment to Hirsch & Associates in the amount of \$300 for work performed on the Live Oak Park Circular Planter Renovation Project.
- Approved a second amendment to the Agreement with The Sauce Creative Services for design and print services for the City's quarterly newsletter.
- Approved a \$50,000 consultant Services Agreement with LECMgt to continue with the development of the emergency preparedness program, training for staff and City Council, and to establish an emergency preparedness outreach program.
- Approved a consultant Services Agreement with RBF Consulting, not to exceed \$98,480, to conduct a comprehensive downtown parking study and a downtown parking strategic plan, and allocated \$100,000 Measure R funds to the parking study and strategic plan.
- Approved a Consultant Services Agreement with RBF Consulting, not to exceed \$91,555, to conduct a city-wide traffic calming study and develop a city-wide traffic calming master plan, and allocated \$100,000 Measure R funds to the study and plan.
- Approved a revised Advertising and Amortization Agreement with the DeLorenzo Family Trust for an upgraded outdoor advertising structure (digital billboard) for property located at 5402 Rosemead Boulevard.
- Received Council reports on the annual League of California Cities Conference, and a recent meeting of the Youth Committee Liaison Ad Hoc Committee.
