09-23-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 9/17/18 8:00am - 9/23/18 4:00pm, in the 5200 block of Degas Avenue. Someone forcibly entered the residence, and stole personal property. Entry was made by shattering the rear glass door. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 2:00pm - 2:40pm, in the 5900 block of Agnes Avenue. Someone entered vehicle through the partially opened window and stole personal property. There were no reported witnesses

09-24-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 6:00pm - 11:30pm, in the 9700 block of Val Street. Someone forcibly entered the residence and stole personal property. Entry was made by shattering the rear glass door. There were no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested a MH/21 at 7:23pm, for **Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance & an Outstanding Petty Theft Warrant**, at Las Tunas Dr/Oak Av. Deputies responded to a person acting insane call and contacted the suspect, who displayed the signs/symptoms of being under the influence of narcotics. The suspect is a resident of Monrovia.

- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 1:55pm, in the 5600 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The suspect entered the location and purchased items with a bogus credit card, then fled the location. There was surveillance video of the incident.
- A **Home Invasion, False Imprisonment** occurred at 8:20pm, in the 6000 block of Kauffman Avenue. The victim awoke, when she saw three male Blacks (suspects) inside of her residence. The suspects stole money and property, then fled the location. The victim was not injured. A witness saw a suspicious white BMW with tinted windows parked across the street from the victim's residence.
- An **Attempt Residential Burglary** occurred at 8:45am, in the 9400 block of Daines Drive. The victim heard a knock at the door, but didn't answer. A short time later, the victim saw two males (suspects) removing a window screen from the side of her residence. The suspects fled the location. A short time earlier, a witness saw a two males exit a silver hatchback vehicle, then knock on the victim's front door. One of the males was wearing a yellow/orange reflective vest.

- An **Attempt Residential Burglary** occurred at 9:34am, in the 9400 block of Blackley Street. Someone attempted to forcibly enter the residence through the bedroom window, but was unsuccessful. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 9/25/18 6:00pm – 9/26/18 6:30pm, in The 10900 block of Freer Street. Someone entered vacant residence, but nothing appeared to be missing. There were no reported witnesses.

There was surveillance video depicting three male Blacks (suspects) inside of the residence taking property. There were no reported witnesses

Entry was made by forcing open the rear door. Several witnesses saw two male Blacks individuals (suspects #1 & 2) exiting the victim's residence, and entering a dark colored sedan.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 7:20pm, in the 4800 block of Kauffman Avenue. Someone forcibly entered the residence, and stole personal property. Entry was made by shattering a bedroom window. There were no reported witnesses.

A male Black & female Black adults (suspects) entered the location and took a number of items from the shelves, then exited without paying. The victim was pushed down by the female suspect, when a witness intervened and help control the suspect until police arrived. The suspect is a resident of Los Angeles.

- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred at 3:00am, in the 5500 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Three males (suspects) forcibly entered the location and stole property. Entry was made by shattering the glass door window. There was surveillance video of the incident.

- Deputies arrested a MH/18 at 8:05pm, for **Petty Theft**, in the 5600 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The suspect (who works at the business) finished his shift, then took items from the location without paying. The suspect is a resident of Temple City.
- An **Attempt Robbery & Assault with a Deadly Weapon** occurred at 8:30pm, in the 5500 block of Alessandro Avenue. The victims agreed to meet up with the suspects, when the suspects attempted to rob the victims at gunpoint. During the encounter, the suspects shot at the victims. There were no reported injuries. This is an ongoing investigation.
- Deputies arrested a MW/25 at 9:38pm for **Assault with a Deadly Weapon & Vandalism**, in the 9400 block of Blackley Street. The victim was assaulted with a blunt instrument by a family member (suspect).
