



CRIME BLOTTER: 10/07/18 – 10/13/18

10-08-18

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 3:00am – 4:05am, in the 5500 block of Santa Anita Avenue. Someone shattered the rear passenger side window of a parked vehicle and stole personal property. A witness saw three male Hispanics (suspects) carrying items from the victim's vehicle, then entering a white Honda Civic (suspect vehicle).

10-09-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 7:50am – 9:35pm, in the 9900 block of Olive Street. Someone entered the residence, but the victim was uncertain if anything was missing at the time. Entry was made by shattering a rear glass door window pane and unlocking the door. There were no reported witnesses.

10-10-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 10:06am, in the 9400 block of Kennerly Street. The victim said a family member did not answer the front door when someone knocked, then the family member saw a male Hispanic wearing a mask (suspect) sliding open the rear kitchen window. The suspect fled immediately once he realized someone was home.
- A **Trespassing** occurred at 12:14pm, in the 9600 block of Woodruff Avenue. The victim saw a male Hispanic (suspect) wearing a mask on the exterior of the property. There was no sign of forced entry.
- A **Conspiracy & Shoplifting** occurred at 4:30pm, in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The victim saw two female Hispanics (suspects) acting in concert to take items from the location, then exit without paying. One female suspect was detained and arrested. During the investigation, it was learned the suspect was acting in concert with two additional suspects who managed to avoid arrest. The arrested suspect was identified by security, as a habitual thief who has stolen merchandise from one business location and returned the items to another business location for profit. The suspect is a resident of Los Angeles.

10-11-18

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 10/10/18 8:00pm – 10/11/18 8:15am, in the 6000 block of Sultana Avenue. Someone shattered the rear window of parked vehicle and stole personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 12:30am – 5:40am, in the 6300 block of Temple City Boulevard. Someone shattered the rear passenger window of parked vehicle and stole personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 12:32am, in the 5000 block of Glickman Avenue. Someone stole personal property from the front porch. There was surveillance video which showed a male (suspect) ride up to the victim's front porch, and take the victim's property.
