



CRIME BLOTTER: 10/21/18 – 10/27/18

10-21-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 5:50pm, in the 5400 block of Loma Avenue. Someone forcibly entered the residence, but the victim was unsure what was taken at the time. Entry was made by shattering the rear glass door. There were no reported witnesses.

10-22-18

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 1:00am – 2:00pm, in the 10800 Freer Street. Someone entered a locked vehicle and stole personal property. There was no sign of forced entry, and no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested a MA/36 at 7:32pm for **Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Resisting a Peace Officer Resulting with Injury, Brandishing a Firearm, & Vandalism**, in the 9800 block of Olive Avenue. Deputies responded to a person with a gun call, and detained the suspect. The suspect possessed several firearms, and allegedly threatened several victims. The suspect kicked out patrol car windows, and caused injury to a deputy. The suspect is a resident of Temple City.

Deputies responded to a traffic collision call and contacted the suspect inside of his vehicle, who displayed the signs/symptoms of a being under the influence of alcohol. The suspect is a resident of Montebello.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 12:00pm – 3:30pm, in the 9800 block of Estrella Avenue. Someone forcibly entered residence and stole personal property. Entry was made by shattering the rear glass door. There were no reported witnesses.
