10-30-18

- Deputies arrested a MW/51 at 9:57pm for **Possession of a Controlled Substance, Two Outstanding Warrants for Possession of a Controlled Substance, & Driving with a Suspended License**, at Lower Azusa Road/Encinita Avenue. The suspect was contacted for a traffic violation, and possessed a suspended license, warrants for his arrest and suspected narcotics. The suspect is a resident of Arcadia.

11-01-18

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 10/31/18 5:00pm-11/1/18 7:10am, in the 5600 Sultana Avenue. Someone shattered the front passenger window of locked vehicle and stole personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred on 9/25/18, but was reported on 11/1/18, in the 6300 block of Rosemead Boulevard. A male (suspect) entered the location and switched bogus lottery tickets for new lottery tickets, when the informant wasn't looking. There is surveillance video of the incident.

- Deputies arrested a MW/50 at 12:40pm for **Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Violation of a Protective Order**, in the 5300 block of Farago Street. The suspect was contacted for tampering with a vehicle, when he appeared under the influence of a controlled substance, was in violation of a restraining order, possessed suspected methamphetamine. The suspect is a resident of Monrovia.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 8:00am-7:00pm, in the 6000 block of Golden West Avenue. Someone entered residence through an unlocked window and stole personal property. There was surveillance video, which shows a female (wearing dark clothing) exiting a vehicle (dark sedan) approaching the victim's residence. The vehicle leaves the location, then returns and parks in the victim's driveway.

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 3:45pm-8:25pm, in the 4900 block of Birchland Place. Someone forcibly entered residence, but was unsure what was missing. Entry was made by shattering a rear door window panel and unlocking the rear door. The victim reported seeing a white vehicle (white Nissan Altima) parked in front of his residence, when he returned home. Once the victim discovered the burglary, he exited his residence and saw the vehicle was gone.
- Deputies arrested a MH/50 at 2:45pm for **Obstruct, Delay, Resist a Peace Officer, Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Outstanding Assault Warrant**, at Lower Azusa Road/El Monte Avenue. The suspect was contacted for a vehicle code violation, appeared under the influence and had an outstanding warrant. The suspect is a resident of El Monte.
