



CRIME BLOTTER: 11/18/18 – 11/24/18

11-18-18

- A **Grand Theft** occurred between 11/17/18 10:00pm – 11/18/18 9:00am, at Livia Avenue/Longden Avenue. Someone stole a part from parked vehicle. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred between 11/17 5:00pm – 11/18 1:30pm, in the 6100 block Encinita Avenue. Someone stole personal property from unlocked vehicle. There was surveillance video of the incident.
- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred at 7:45pm, in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard. A male Black (suspect) entered the location and stole personal property, which was left unattended, then ran outside to a waiting vehicle (white, possible Toyota or Hyundai). There was a reported witness.

11-19-18

- A **Residential Robbery/Burglary** occurred at 8:30pm, in the 6300 block of Encinita Avenue. The victim said he heard a window break, then saw two male Blacks (suspects) inside of his residence. One suspect was armed with a knife and gave orders to the victim, as the second suspect searched for jewelry and money. The suspects eventually left the location, and the victim was unharmed.

11-20-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 10:50am, in the 5000 block of Kauffman Avenue. Someone shattered the rear window of the residence, then fled the location without making entry. The victim saw a silver sedan (possible Hyundai) driving away from the location.

11-22-18

- A **Robbery** occurred at 9:40am, in the 5600 block of Rosemead Boulevard. A male Hispanic (suspect) entered the business and took several items, then threatened the victim with a gardening tool. The suspect exited without paying for the merchandise and entered a silver vehicle (possible Ford Edge). There was a reported witness and surveillance video of the incident.

11-24-18

- A **Stolen Vehicle** occurred between 7:30pm – 8:00pm, in the 5500 block of Cloverly Avenue. Someone stole parked vehicle. There were no reported witnesses.
