



# CRIME BLOTTER: 11/25/18 – 12/01/18

## 11-25-18

- An **Attempted Residential Burglary** occurred between 6:30pm – 7:30pm, in the 5100 block of Barela Avenue. Someone attempted to enter the residence, but believes his dog discouraged the entry. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 8:03pm, in the 9300 block of Olive Street. A witness saw two males (suspects) running from his neighbor's (victim's) residence to a dark colored SUV parked in the victim's driveway. The suspects forced entry into the victim's residence by shattering a rear window, but unsure if anything was missing. The victim was out of town at the time.

- A **Stolen Vehicle** occurred between 11/12 – 11/26, in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Someone stole a motorcycle from the location. There were no reported witnesses.
