01-07-19

- An **Attempt Vehicle Burglary** occurred at 10:45am, at El Monte Avenue/Grand Avenue. The victim said the suspect was attempting to enter her parked vehicle, before the suspect was scared off by a witness. The suspect was detained and arrested a short time later. The suspect is a resident El Monte.

01-08-19

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 12:00am – 4:10pm, in the 5600 block of Gracewood Avenue. The victim said someone shattered her parked vehicle front passenger window, but she was unsure what was missing at the time. There were no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested a FW/60 at 1:30pm for **Petty Theft**, in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Drive. The witness said the suspect entered the business and selected items, then exited without paying. The suspect was detained outside and placed under private person's arrest. The suspect is a resident of Barstow.

01-09-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 8:21pm, in the 9800 block of Val Street. Deputies responded to an alarm call and discovered someone shattered the rear door window, but were unsure if anything was taken at the time. The victim was out of town, and there were no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested a MH/31 for **Illegal Possession of Teargas, Misappropriation of Property & Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**, at Rosemead Boulevard/Las Tunas Drive. The suspect was contacted for a vehicle code violation while riding a bicycle, when deputies recovered suspected illegal narcotics, identification in another person's name and illegal possession of teargas. The suspect is a resident of El Monte.

1-10-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 2:50pm – 3:00pm, in the 5300 block of Santa Anita Avenue. The witness said he was home, when two males (suspects) wearing green hooded sweatshirts smashed the rear glass door of the residence. The suspects were scared off when the witness was present and yelled out. The suspects did not make entry into the location.
