



CRIME BLOTTER: 12/16/18 – 12/22/18

12-16-18

- A **Grand Theft** occurred between 12/11 4:00pm – 12/21 11:00am, on Linden Lane. Someone broke into the victim's locked bedroom and stole personal property. The informant suspects persons who rented the location of committing the theft. There were no reported witnesses.

12-17-18

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 11:00am, in the 10200 block of Nadine Street. Someone forcibly entered the residence and stole personal property. Entry was made by shattering the rear door. There was surveillance video of the incident.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 8:21pm, in the 6000 block of Golden West Avenue. Deputies responded to an alarm call and saw someone forced entry into the location, but they were unsure if anything was taken. Entry was made by shattering the rear kitchen window. There were no reported witnesses.

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 10:39pm, in the 5000 block of Sereno Drive. Someone entered unlocked residence and stole personal property. There was no sign of forced entry and no reported witnesses.

12-20-18

- A **Theft by Trick Device** occurred at 5:35pm, in the 5500 block of McCulloch Avenue. The victim received a call from an unknown male (suspect) claiming the victim had an outstanding arrest warrant and needed to pay a large sum of money. The victim paid the money, then learned he was scammed.

12-21-18

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 12/20 6:00pm – 12/21 5:00am, in the 5600 block of Welland Avenue. Someone shattered the rear window of parked vehicle, and stole victim's purse. There were no reported witnesses.

12-22-18

- Deputies arrested a MA/44 at 2:06pm for **Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, & Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia**, in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Deputies responded to a call of a person smoking narcotics at the location and detained the suspect. The suspect appeared under the influence of narcotics and possessed a narcotics pipe. The suspect is a resident of Pasadena.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 4:15pm, in the 5000 block of Camellia Avenue. Someone forcibly entered the residence, but was unsure what was taken at the time. Entry was made by shattering the rear window. There were no reported witnesses.
