03-04-19

- Deputies arrested a MH/19 at 12:30pm for **Robbery & Burglary**, in the 9800 block of Las Tunas Drive. The suspect was arrested a short time later, after he threatened the victim with a screwdriver and stole money. There were witnesses & surveillance video of the incident. The suspect is a resident of Temple City.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 6:40am – 5:10pm, in the 6100 block of Primrose Avenue. The victim said someone shattered the rear bedroom window of his residence and made entry, but nothing appeared to be missing. There were no reported witnesses.

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 10:30am – 3:10pm, in the 5200 block of Agnes Avenue. The victim said two suspects shattered the rear sliding glass door of the location and stole personal property from the victims. There was surveillance video of two males of unknown race but one wearing a reflector vest exiting the residence with bags of property.
