



# CRIME BLOTTER: 03/10/18 – 03/16/19

## 03-11-19

- Deputies arrested a MW/33 at 10:00pm for **Violation of a Restraining Order & Possession of a Controlled Substance**, in the 5500 block of Welland Avenue. The victim had a restraining order against the suspect, who possessed suspected narcotics. The suspect is a resident of Pasadena.

## 03-12-19

- Two **Vehicle Vandalisms** occurred between 3/11 8:00am – 3/12 5:00pm in the 5000 block of Sereno Drive. The victim had his vehicle parked on the street in front of his house overnight. The driver's side rear window was shattered and a single scratch was made on the passenger side. No entry was made into the vehicle and there was no video surveillance of the incident. The second victim had her vehicle parked outside in a parking lot near the residence. The right rear passenger window was shattered. There was nothing taken from inside the vehicles. The victim's video surveillance caught a tan colored pick truck enter the driveway in reverse, then a few seconds later drive forward and out of view.
- A **Vehicle Vandalism** occurred between 11:00am – 12:30pm, in the 9000 block of Lemon Avenue. The victim's vehicle was parked on a shared driveway and was scratched along the driver's side. There was no video surveillance of the incident. The victim stated there is a family feud amongst the family and believes a relative is possibly the one who vandalized the vehicle.

## 03-13-19

- A **Prowling** occurred at 12:30pm in the 5000 block on Camellia Avenue. Video surveillance showed two male blacks jump over a gate and enter the backyard of the residence. A third person described as a female black was seen walking towards the area of the front door. After a short time she walked away from the front door and entered a white Honda Civic, which was parked in front of the home, with blue paper plates. The vehicle was seen driving southbound on Camellia Avenue and out of the cameras view. The alarm was activated by the victim, which scared the two suspects causing them to run back towards the driveway and out of the cameras view. This incident was related to the arrest on 3/14.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 1:56pm in the 8000 block of Roccus Lane. Two suspects entered the location through an open window and stole personal property from the victims. Video surveillance showed one male black jump a fence and enter into the rear yard of the residence. Moments later a second male black also entered the rear yard. A newer model 4-door Honda Civic, white in color was parked in front of the residence and was not recognized by the victim. This incident was related to the arrest on 3/14.

**03-14-19**

- Deputies arrested a FB/19 and a MB/18 for **Residential Burglary**, in the 5500 block of Baldwin Avenue. Deputies made a traffic stop for California Vehicle Code violations and recognized the vehicle from a previous residential burglary.
- A **Residential Burglary** occurred 9:30pm in the 5000 block of Hart Avenue. The victim said the suspect shattered a sliding door of the location and stole personal property from the victim. There was no video surveillance and no reported witnesses.
