



CRIME BLOTTER: 03/17/18 – 03/23/19

03-18-19

- A **Robbery & Kidnapping** occurred at 4:12pm, in the 9500 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim was approached by a suspect, who grabbed her purse and ran to a nearby waiting vehicle. The victim refused to let go of the purse and was pulled to a nearby vehicle, then dragged by the suspect inside moving vehicle. The victim suffered injuries and was nearly struck by moving vehicles. The suspects were wearing masks at the time.
- A **Petty Theft & Attempt Access by card** occurred at 5:46pm, in the 5700 block of Agnes Avenue. The victim said a female Hispanic (suspect 25 yrs old, black hair) stole a package containing credit cards from her front porch, then attempted to use the cards to make unauthorized purchases. There was surveillance video of the incident.
- A **Petty Theft Shoplifting** occurred at 7:58pm, in the 5700 block of Rosemead Boulevard. The informant said three female Blacks (suspects) entered the location and took property, then exited without paying. There were witnesses and surveillance video of the incident.

03-20-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred at 11:44am, in the 4900 block of Halifax Avenue. Deputies responded to an open door or window call and discovered the residence was burglarized, but it was unknown what was taken at the time. There were no reported witnesses.

03-21-19

- A **Residential Burglary** occurred between 10:30am – 12:30pm, in the 10900 block of Freer Street. The informant said someone shattered her bedroom window and stole her personal property. The victim's alarm was unarmed and there were no reported witnesses.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 1:41pm, in the 4900 block of El Monte Avenue. The victim said a male (suspect) wearing a red hoodie stole a package from his front porch. There were no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested a MW/32 at 8:20pm, for **Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance**, in the 9500 block of Las Tunas Drive. Deputies saw the suspect hiding in bushes and noticed he displayed the signs/symptoms of being under the influence of narcotics and unable to care for himself. The suspect is a resident of El Monte.

03-22-19

- An **Assault with a Deadly Weapon** occurred at 8:46pm, in the 10300 block of Key West Street. The suspect attempted to seriously injure the victim, then threatened to cause an explosion. The suspect is known to the victims. This is an ongoing investigation.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred on 3/12/19 at 11:30am, but was reported on 3/22/19, in the 9000 block of Olive Street. The victim said someone stole his personal property from his residence. The victim suspects he knows who took his property. There was no sign of forced entry and no reported witnesses.
- A **Fraudulent use of an Access Card & Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 6:30pm – 7:45pm, in the 9800 block of Richmond Way. The victim said someone shattered her parked vehicle front passenger window and stole her purse from the front passenger seat. The suspects used the credit card to make several unauthorized purchases.

03-23-19

- Deputies arrested a MH/50 at 10:21am for **Possession of a Controlled Substance, Trespassing on Railroad Property, Public Urination & Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia**, At Lower Azusa Road/Union Pacific Railroad Train Tracks. The Deputy observed the suspect trespassing & urinating on the railroad tracks. The suspect additionally possessed suspected narcotics and narcotics paraphernalia. The suspect is a resident of San Gabriel.
- Deputies arrested a MH/30 at 1:44pm for **Identity Theft**, in the 6300 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Deputies responded to a possible vehicle burglary in progress call and contacted the suspect who was in possession of credit card information that did not belong to him, nor did he didn't have permission to possess. The suspect is a resident of Moreno Valley.
- A **Strong Robbery** occurred at 2:49pm, at Camellia Avenue/Las Tunas Drive. The victim said a male (suspect) wearing a red hoodie ran behind her and stole her purse, then entered a newer model burgundy vehicle (possible Nissan Altima), driven by a second male suspect. There were no reported witnesses or video surveillance of the incident.
