04-01-19

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 3/31 7:00pm – 4/1 8:30am, in the 5000 block of Gracewood Avenue. The victim said someone shattered the rear passenger window of his parked vehicle and stole his personal property. There were no reported witnesses.
