04-07-19

- Deputies arrested a FH/35 at 5:00am for **Possession of Burglary Tools, Possession of a Controlled Substance & Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia**, at Las Tunas Drive/Alessandro Avenue. The suspect was contacted for a vehicle code violation on a bicycle and possessed items consistent with committing burglaries, along with narcotics and narcotics paraphernalia. The suspect is a resident of Alhambra.

- Deputies arrested a FW/A for **Grand Theft & Vandalism**, in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Drive. The deputy was flagged down by the victim, who identified the suspect from surveillance video as the person who stole and damaged his business property. The suspect is a local transient.

The driver suspect used his vehicle as a barricade while he and the passenger suspect watched an illegal exhibition of speed contest. The suspect failed to stop his vehicle and partially struck the deputy. The suspect was pursued a distance before stopping for the deputy. The suspects are residents of Riverside and Corona.
