**MEETING MINUTES
JULY 5, 2019**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Councilmember Man called the Facilities, Public Works, and Infrastructure Standing Committee meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS – None

4. PRELIMINARY DESIGN CONCEPT FOR PRIMROSE PARK

Parks and Recreation Manager Lawson provided an update on the design of Primrose Park. He summarized the community meetings held on June 1 and June 19, 2019, which were aimed at soliciting feedback from residents and local stakeholders regarding the park's potential design. He then presented the two concept design options created by David Volz Design (DVD) based on said feedback and introduced Gary Vasquez from DVD to further discuss.

Gary Vasquez provided a detailed overview of both Concept Plan Option 1 and Concept Plan Option 2. Within each option he discussed the park's orientation; parking lot; amenities; landscape and hardscape; and ingress and egress.

The Standing Committee received the update and provided staff with feedback on both design options, including access points, fencing, amenities, environmental opportunities, parking lot design, and general theme. No formal direction was given.
