

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of May 5, 2020. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of May 5, 2020, the City Council:

- Proclaimed May “Older American Month” and honored 2020 Older American of the Year, Mr. James Ponnet;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of April 21, 2020;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of April 28, 2020;
- Received and filed the Planning Commission Meeting Actions of March 10, 2020;
- Accepted the Engineer’s Report for the Temple City Citywide Lighting and Maintenance District for FY 2020-21 and adopted Resolution No. 20-5468;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5469 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Directed staff bring back additional information focusing on rental assistance and small business assistance program for Council’s consideration at the next meeting on the use of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds that the City will receive as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act; and directed staff to return at the end of fiscal year (FY) 2019-2020 with a recommendation on modifying the CDBG programs for FY 2020-2021 to provide relief related to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Approved Resolution No. 20-5472 to approve the resurfacing of various streets citywide as Temple City’s designated project for Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-2021 pursuant to Senate Bill 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (SB 1); directed the City Manager to include the corresponding Capital Improvement Projects (CIPs) in the FY 2020-21 City Budget including RMRA funds and the required General Fund maintenance of effort match; and authorized the City Manager to submit the required documents and information to the California Transportation Commission (CTC) for the City to receive RMRA funds;
- Extended paid administrative leave for employees until May 31, 2020;
- Nominated three nominees (i.e. Planning Commissioner Serge Haddad, former Councilmember/Mayor Fernando Vizcarra, and former Councilmember/Mayor Peter Zovak) to fill by appointment the Council seat vacated by former Councilmember Fish and provided staff direction on the appointment process;
- Dissolved the Library Construction Standing Committee;
- Appointed Mayor Chavez to the City and School District Standing Committee;

- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
