

## **CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of May 19, 2020. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the regular meeting of May 19, 2020, the City Council:

- Proclaimed the month of May “Building Safety Month”;
- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of May 5, 2020;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 8, 2020;
- Approved Minutes of the Special City Council Meeting of May 11, 2020;
- Received and filed the Planning Commission Meeting Actions of April 28, 2020;
- Approved a new agreement between the City of Temple City and the San Gabriel Valley Humane Society for animal control, shelter, and licensing services for Fiscal Year 2020-21 and authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5474 approving participation in the CDBG Program and authorize the Mayor, or the Mayor’s designee, to sign a cooperation agreement with the County of Los Angeles;
- Approved the Proposition A Local Return fund exchange with Foothill Transit, authorized the City Manager to execute the Assignment Agreement, and approved the budget amendments increasing Expenditure Budget of \$750,000 from Proposition A Fund and increase Revenue Budget of \$562,500 in the General Fund;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5467 accepting and approving the 2020 Temple City Engineering and Traffic Survey and recommended speed limits on various streets within the City of Temple City;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5475 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2019-20;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5473 ordering the levy and collection of assessments for FY 2020-21;
- Received and filed the FY 2019-20 Third Quarter Budget Review and related reports and authorized staff to make the budget adjustments in Attachment A of the staff report;
- Directed staff to explore both the Temporary Rental Assistance Program and the Small Business Assistance Program and bring this discussion back to Council for further discussion, and in the interim to work on setting up each program so that the council’s future direction can be carried out more quickly;
- Directed staff to proceed with the custom storage and bathroom design as presented by staff and approve progressing with the design and bidding process for the Primrose Park Project;
- Appointed Mayor Chavez to the City and School District Standing Committee;

- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
