**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 4, 2020**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Chavez called the City Council Special Meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. telephonically.

3. NEW BUSINESS

A. REQUEST TO INCREASE CARES ACT FUNDING TO CITIES

The state legislature is deliberating the Governor's revised budget proposal, ahead of the June 15 constitutional deadline for the legislature to pass the state budget. Approval of the requested letter supports an alternative proposal by the League of California Cities to boost the state's CARES Act funding to cities; it also calls for Senator Rubio and Assemblymember Chau to support this measure as they consider passage of the state budget.

City Manager Cook gave a brief summary of the staff report.
