

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of January 19, 2021. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the special meeting of January 19, 2021, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding one item of Anticipated Litigation. City Council received briefing from the City Attorney and there is no reportable action.

At the regular meeting of January 19, 2021, the City Council:

- Approved Minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting of January 5, 2021;
- Approved a Consultant Services Agreement with RRM to prepare the objective design standards and authorized the City Manager to execute the Consultant Services Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$178,248;
- Directed community preservation staff to refrain from enforcing the portion of City's public nuisance ordinance related to holiday lights, decorations, and displays until the local state of emergency ends;
- Received an update for the overnight parking enforcement. Enforcement will remain suspended while the State's Regional Stay at Home Order for the Southern California Region and the County's Revised Temporary Targeted Safer at Home Health Officer Order for Control of COVID-19: Tier 1 Substantial Surge Update Response Orders remain in effect;
- Received and filed an update of the COVID-19 Continuity Plan;
- Adopted Resolution No. 20-5508 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2020-21;
- Received and filed a report on newly enacted state laws that will impact city services and policies and directed the City Manager to implement all required procedures and policies in alignment with new and applicable state laws;
- Received and filed the:
 1. Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for the year ended June 30, 2020;
 2. Independent Auditor's Communication to the City;
 3. Independent Accountants' Report on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures Related to the Article XIII-B Appropriations Limit Calculation (Gann Limit); and
 4. Independent Auditor's Report on Internal Control over Financial Reporting and on Compliance and Other Matters Based on an Audit of Financial Statements Performed in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* ;
- Received and filed the Mid-Year Fiscal Year 2020-21 (i.e., July 2020 to December 2020) Financial Status Review and related reports and approved and authorized staff to revise revenue and expenditure budget estimates as proposed;

- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
