12-29-19

- A **Petty Theft** occurred at 12:40am, in the 5000 block of Muscatel Avenue. The victim said someone stole a package from their front porch. There was no surveillance video of the incident.
- A **Robbery** occurred at 11:30am, in the 9300 block of Broadway Avenue. The suspect threatened the victim and demanded his wallet. The victim gave the suspect his property, the suspect entered a vehicle and drove out of view.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred between 8:00pm – 8:30pm, in the 9600 block of Las Tunas Drive. The suspect entered the unlocked vehicle and stole personal property. There was surveillance video of the incident.

12-30-19

- Two **Commercial Burglaries** occurred between 11/30 – 12/7, but were reported 12/30, in the 9700 block of Garibaldi Avenue. The Informant said someone entered the location and stole property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Petty Theft** occurred 3:35pm, in the 10000 block of Freer Avenue. The suspect pretended to deliver an envelope, then took a package that was already on the porch. There was surveillance video of the incident.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred 5:30pm, in the 9600 block of Las Tunas Drive. The suspect took property from a counter top and ran out of the store. There was no surveillance video of the incident.

- A **Theft By False Pretenses** occurred between 12/20 10:30pm – 12/22 12:00am, but was reported on 12/31, in the 5100 block of Sereno Drive. The victim was scammed via the internet of over one thousand dollars.

- An **Armed Robbery** occurred at 1:00pm, in the 9400 block of Las Tunas Drive. The victim said the suspect was armed with a handgun, when he took money from the cash register and left the location.

01-03-20

- Deputies arrested a MW/18 at 7:45am for **Possession of a Controlled Substance & Possession of Prescription Narcotics**, at Hart Avenue/Garibaldi Avenue. Deputies contacted the suspect for digging through trash cans, and recovered suspected narcotics from the suspect. The suspect is a resident of San Gabriel.
