03-08-20

- A **Vandalism** occurred between 3/7 9:00pm – 3/8 4:00pm, in the 9900 block of Woodruff Avenue. The victim said someone vandalized the entire passenger side of his parked vehicle. There were no reported witnesses
- Deputies arrested a MH/50 at 5:30pm for **Possession of a Controlled Substance**, in the 5800 block of Rosemead Boulevard. Deputies responded to a disturbance call and recovered suspected narcotics. The suspect is a resident of Los Angeles.

- An **Unauthorized Use of a Computer & Acquiring ones' Personal Identification with Intent to Defraud**, in the 5100 block of Farago Avenue. The victim received a call from a person identifying themselves as a worker from a federal agency, and hacked the victim's personal computer obtaining personal information. There were no reported witnesses.

- A **Garage Burglary & Petty Theft** occurred at 5:07am, in 9800 block of Richmond Avenue. The victim said someone entered her unlocked vehicle and stole her personal property, then accessed her garage and stole additional property. There were no reported witnesses.
- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred between 3/9 6:30pm – 3/10 5:15am, in the 5500 block of Welland Avenue. The victim said someone smashed the rear passenger window of his parked vehicle, but he was unsure what was missing at the time. There were no reported witnesses.
- Deputies arrested MH/56 & FH/27 at 12:19am, for **Transportation of a Controlled Substance for Sales, Unlicensed Driver & other charges**, at Muscatel Avenue/Garibaldi, Avenue. The suspect vehicle was contacted for a vehicle code violation and suspected narcotics were recovered. The suspects were residents of Pasadena and Los Angeles.

- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred at 2:12am, in the 4900 block of Camellia Avenue. The victim said a male (suspect) entered her unlocked vehicle, but she was unsure what was taken at the time. There was no sign of forced entry. There was video surveillance of a male entering the vehicle, then exiting a short time later.
- A **Vehicle Burglary** occurred at 4:30am, in the 4800 block of Alessandro Avenue. The victim said a male (suspect) entered her locked vehicle and stole her personal property. There was no sign of forced entry. There is video showing the suspect opening the driver's side door of the victim's vehicle, removing items, then entering a white sedan.

There was surveillance video showing two males acting in concert to remove the tire, then entering a silver Toyota Camry with no front plate.
- A **Grand Theft** occurred at 5:45pm, in the 4800 block of Temple City Boulevard. The victim said a male Asian (suspect) reached inside of the open window of her parked vehicle and stole her purse. The suspect entered a gray Nissan, driven by a second suspect and fled the location.
