08-10-20

- Deputies arrested a MH/46 and FH/35 at 6:35am on Lower Azusa Rd/Union Pacific Railroad for **Trespassing on Railroad Property**. Both suspects have been previously warned/advised of the violation for trespassing on railroad property. The male suspect is residence of Los Angeles and the female is a residence of El Monte.

- A **Commercial Burglary** occurred between 08/08/20 at 8:00pm and 08/11/20 at 1:00pm on the 5600 block of Rosemead Blvd. Unknown suspect(s) entered the business by shattering a glass window to the location and stole miscellaneous computers and office items. Unknown suspect(s) entered the residence by prying open the metal garage door and ransacked the residence.
