

**CITY OF TEMPLE CITY  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS**

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of February 21, 2023. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special meeting of February 21, 2023, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Potential Litigation”. There is no reportable action; and
- Did not discuss Closed Session item “Labor Negotiation”. This item will be rescheduled for a future meeting.

At the Regular meeting of February 21, 2023, the City Council:

- Recognized the 2023 Camellia Royal Court;
- Approved the City Council Special Meeting Minutes of February 7, 2023 and Regular Meeting Minutes of February 7, 2023 and found that the City Council Minutes is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Received and filed the Transportation and Public Safety Commission Actions of January 11, 2023, and February 8, 2023, and found that the Commission Actions is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Received and filed FY 2021-22 Proposition A, Proposition C, Measure R, Measure M, and Transportation Development Act Article 3 Audit Reports and found that adoption of Resolution 23-5654 is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15061(b)(3);
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5657 adopting the City’s amended Records Retention Schedule and found that adoption of the resolution is not a “Project” as defined under Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines; therefore, pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3) no environmental review is required;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5656 proclaiming the termination of a local emergency and found that adoption of the resolution is not a “Project” as defined under Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines, therefore, pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3), no environmental review is required;
- Received and filed the Visa Card Report and found that adoption of the resolution is not a “Project” as defined under Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines; therefore, pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3), no environmental review is required;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5658 approving payment of bills for Fiscal Year 2022-23;
- Received and filed the updated on the City’s Campaign Contribution Limit for 2023-2024;
- Introduced for first reading by title only and waived further reading of Ordinance No. 23-1069, Series C Code Amendments of Title 9 (Zoning Regulations), Chapter 1 (Zoning Code) with amendments to Section 6 and 15 and deleted Section 9,11,12,13, scheduled the second reading of Ordinance No. 23-1069 for March 7, 2023, scheduled the adoption of Resolution No. 23-5653 “Amendments to the General Plan Land Use Element to Clarify Mixed-Use and Residential Densities” for March 7, 2023, and found that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager;
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
