

CITY OF TEMPLE CITY CITY COUNCIL MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from their meeting of April 18, 2023. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The Minutes, once approved by the City Council at a subsequent meeting, become the official record of the meeting.

At the Special meeting of April 18, 2023, the City Council:

- Met in Closed Session regarding “Potential Litigation”. There is no reportable action;
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Significant Exposure to Litigation, Facts Unknown to the Plaintiff”. There is no reportable action; and
- Met in Closed Session regarding “Conference with Labor Negotiation”. There is no reportable action.

At the Regular meeting of April 18, 2023, the City Council:

- Received a brief introduction from Chamber of Commerce’s new President/CEO John Bwarie;
- Congratulated Commander Mark Reyes on his recent promotion from Captain to Commander;
- Received and filed the City Council Special and Regular Meeting Minutes of April 4, 2023;
- Adopted Ordinance No. 23-1070 amending Title 9, Chapters 1 of the Municipal Code related to artificial turf, landscaping and hardscape, and found that this Ordinance is not subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that the Ordinance has no possibility of a significant effect on the environment. Further, any project reviewed under this ordinance would be a class 1, 3, 4, or 5 categorical exemption;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5663 ordering the preparation of the Lighting and Maintenance Assessment District Annual Engineer’s Report for FY 2023-2024;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5664 authorizing the payment of bills;
- Introduced Ordinance No. 23-1072 for first reading by title only, found that the ordinance is exempt from CEQA per Section 15061(b)(3) and Section 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines, waived further reading of Ordinance No. 23-1072, and Scheduled the second reading for May 2, 2023;
- Approved the Minutes of the Regular Successor Agency to the Former Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency meeting of February 7, 2023;
- Adopted Resolution No. 23-5665-SA authorizing payment of bills for the Successor Agency to the Former Temple City Community Redevelopment Agency;
- Received updates from the City Attorney and City Manager; and
- Received Councilmember reports on items separate from the meeting agenda.
